



RENTAL SPAS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Simply Spas Hot Tub Hire requires all persons hiring equipment to have read and understood the contents of this document before signing. If you do not understand the information contained within this document, or require further clarification on any points, please don't hesitate to speak to us.

At the end of this document you will be asked for your signature and date of signing. It should be noted that you are signing to accept the equipment as outlined below and have read/understood all points highlighted within the terms and conditions.

Our seasonal spa hire price is 2500€- 5000€ for seasonal rental, depending on the size of the spa. Delivery and uplift are charged at 495€. If any lifting equipment is necessary to put the spa in place and take it out again this will be invoiced separately at cost price. Payment must be made in full before delivery.

Seasonal Winter rentals will be uplifted at the end of April after the closure of the ski lifts at a mutually convenient date.

Seasonal Summer rentals will be uplifted after 15th September at a mutually convenient date.

The renter must be present on delivery and uplift.

The spa remains the responsibility of the renter throughout the rental period and cannot be left at any property if they are absent.

Our spas must be cleaned and dosed regularly throughout the full term of the rental period.

Any faults must be reported immediately. Any breakages or damage to the spa, cover or steps will be charged for and must be paid in full on uplift.

The spa must be clean and in full working order on uplift, we will check the spa, empty and take it away.

All rentals have an option to buy, we will make contact 6 weeks before uplift and offer a buying price for the spa. Decision must be made at least 1 month prior to uplift. Payment, if bought, must be made before the end of the rental season.

Please note that the spa remains the property of Simply Spas throughout the full term of the rental period. If the spa is neglected or abused we can uplift at any time.

Simply Spas will not be held responsible for any damage, injuries or death resulting from the misuse of our hot tubs. We will also not be held responsible for any damage caused by the hot tub.

The hot-tub and cover are the renters responsibility. We recommend contacting your household insurance company to inform them of the hire and ask them to provide cover.

If the hot-tub or cover is damaged , a replacement will be charged for.

Any damage incurred due to misuse or not following the guidelines must be paid for in full.

Undersigned renter understands the above information and acknowledges that the use of the hot tub is at the renters' risk. Undersigned renter agrees to release this establishment from any and all liabilities incurred with the use of the hot tub.

A 500€ security deposit will be charged, this will be refunded within two weeks of the spa uplift after inspection.

Please make sure the spa is clean and in good condition when returned.

Guidelines

The hot tub must always be filled with cold or lukewarm water, never hot water, and will take at least 24 hours to reach the recommended temperature of between 37c and 39c. Filters must be taken out and cleaned regularly, at least twice a week.

To change water temperature simply press pad down for cooler and up for hotter, manuals can be found in our information centre at www.simplyspas-alps.com

Our rental tubs seat from 5-8 people, depending on the size of the spa. Please do not overload as this can cause damage.

When using the hot tub, remove cover and store carefully. Enter water carefully. Always use plastic glasses while in the spa

Over filling the hot tub will cause it to overflow and could cause damage.

When not using hot tub always replace the cover to retain heat.

The hot tub will maintain temperature by itself; although during periods of heavy use or when the cover is removed for an extended period there will be a fall in temperature. Staying out of the hot tub and replacing the cover will allow the water temperature to rise to the desired level.

Always leave the hot tub switched on in order for the filtration/heating systems to work. If the spa is off for any length of time in extreme cold the spa would freeze. This is catastrophic for a spa and would result in the spa being charged for in full

Do not use any electrical items within five feet of the hot tub.

Children must be over five years of age and accompanied by an adult at all times when using the hot tub.

At more than 37.5c you should not spend more than twenty minutes in the hot tub.

Pregnant women and persons with heart disease, circulatory problems, diabetes or low or high blood pressure should consult a doctor before using the hot tub.

It is essential that everyone using the hot tub, showers before use and no foreign bodies e.g. grass, earth, sand, stones or sharp objects are introduced to the water.

Chemicals will need to be added. Please take a look at “Hot-tubs for Beginners” in our information centre for care instructions. If you have any questions just ask!
